- 1 Our monthly prayer focus allows us to individually pray for each child.
- 2 Caregivers lovingly care for and play with children, striving to meet each child's individual needs.
- 3 We are sensitive to individual needs. Teddy Grams and Cheerios are offered as snacks. If your child has food allergies, please let us know.
- 4 Unless otherwise requested, we plan to check your child's diaper and change it if needed. Potty training children will be encouraged to use the toilet and wash their hands.



Welcome

- 1 To ensure the safety of all children, please visit a Check-In Kiosk. Here, you will receive a nametag with a number and a security pickup tag. If there is a need, your child's number will be displayed in the auditorium.
- 2 Sign in your child at the nursery counter. Leave everything your child may need: bottle, pacifier, special blanket, and/or diapers. Please have your child's name on all personal items.
- 3 We hope you feel welcomed, but request you remain mindful of your "visiting," and pick up your child promptly after the worship/teaching time. You will need your pick-up tag for security purposes.

Safety & Health

- 1 We carefully screen all caregivers.
- 2 Toys and equipment are sanitized after each service.
- 3 In the interest of everyone's health, please ensure that your child is well. Symptoms of illness include fever, vomiting, diarrhea, cough, runny nose, or a rash.
- 4 Nursery-aged children with disabilities are welcome. If your child has special needs, please educate us on providing the best care.
