WHAT IS THE FRC?

The FRC members should see their core role as both advisors for, and eyes of, the congregation. While they are not expected to provide vision, priorities or directional input for the church, they are asked (and expected) to provide robust feedback, wise counsel and essential suggestions to the Elder Board on our present course of action and expenditures.

The Financial Review Committee (FRC) is a group of Grace Community Church members who are annually commissioned by the Elder Board to serve one or two year terms under the Executive Pastor to ensure integrity within the church's financial dealings. For effective accountability, to be above reproach and for the overall well being of the church, the Elder Board will also annually appoint a co-chair to assist in leading this committee. The co-chair will be either a lay Elder or possess the qualities of an Elder. This co-chair will be selected by the Elder Board.

Qualifications of Members

People of strength and resolve. They do not simply comply, but are willing and able to ask well informed questions.

People who are humble, leading servants. They are not at all interested in establishing their own agenda.

People who are known in the church. We will put them in front of the church as "the eyes of the congregation".

People who will effectively be able to share our "macro budget/spending" with the congregation each year. More detailed reports will always be available upon request.
